Easter Egg Hunt

We will have our classroom Easter Egg Hunts on Wednesday 4/5 & Thursday 4/6 around 10:45am. The hunts will be on the playground, the CLC will be utilized if we have rain.

Parents are welcome to attend and we will need volunteers to help hide eggs prior to our hunt.

We ask that each child send in 12 pre-filled eggs for the hunt. You can fill them with small candies, stickers, small toys, etc. We will ask for parent help in making sure each child leaves with 12 eggs at the end of the hunt.

Prior to the hunt, please let us know if you will be taking your child home afterwards or if they will be staying until pick up. If they leave after the hunt, they will not need a lunch. If they stay a lunch will be needed.



Please make sure to send a jacket everyday! As the weather warms up, we will be outside more and sometimes the temperature during our playground time can be a tad chilly in the shade.

With more playground time, remember closed toed shoes are best for playground play and crocs are not great for climbing or running, sneakers are best.
