



## MAY PRESCHOOL NEWS

It's hard to believe the end of the school year is upon us. Many thanks to everyone who donated time, money, and talents to make this a wonderful year for us!

The children attending **Balls Creek Elementary** next year will be touring the school on **Wednesday, April 29<sup>th</sup>**. Your child will need to be picked up and arrive at the front entrance of the Balls Creek School **no later than 1:00 pm**. Parents will need to show their driver's license to enter the school. We will meet in the lobby, take a picture and then the CHILDREN will tour the school. **The school has requested that parents wait in the media center during the tour. There will still be class at preschool for the children that normally attend that day and are not going on the field trip.**

The children attending **Sherrills Ford Elementary** next year will be touring the school on **Monday, May 4<sup>th</sup>**. Your child will need to be picked up and arrive at the front entrance of Sherrills Ford School **no later than 12:00 pm**. Parents will need to show their driver's license to enter the school. Payments for that week will be due on the first preschool day of each month. If you pay for all the weeks in one month, you will receive a \$10.00 discount.

If your child is attending preschool next year or coming to the summer program, you will be receiving an invitation to join **Brightwheel**. Once you receive this invitation, please set up the account for your child. This app will be replacing the Procure app and will be the way we will be communicating with our parents. We have a few families that will be attending our summer program that have been selected to help us during this transition. We are excited to make this change and hope that you bear with us during the transition period.
